Addendum to the Frequency Coordination Agreement between the Administrations of Malta and Italy for the use of radio spectrum in the 174-230 MHz band signed on 11th October 2019

- 1. In line with article 4 of the Frequency Coordination Agreement entered into between the Administrations of Malta and Italy for the use of radio spectrum in the 174-230 MHz band signed on 11 October 2019 ("Agreement") and after taking into consideration the comments made by the Administration of Greece on 31 October 2019 (reference 14294/2019) with regard to Annex 1 of the said Agreement concerning the Distribution of the digital terrestrial broadcasting frequency blocks in the exclusive zone, the Administrations of Malta and Italy are hereby replacing in its entirety Annex 1 of the Agreement with the revised Annex 1 found within this Addendum concerning the revised Distribution of the digital terrestrial broadcasting frequency blocks in the exclusive zone.
- **2.** The official correspondence (reference 14294/2019) from the Administration of Greece is included in this Addendum as Annex 2 for ease of reference.
- 3. This Addendum is not modifying any of the other articles found within the Agreement.

Dear Mrs Spina,

Thank you for the organization of the coordination meeting between the three countries and for your effort to prepare the table of distribution of the 32 blocks in VHF band III.

We have studied the proposed distribution and concluded that we cannot accept the possibility of using channel 8 in the provinces of Ragusa, Siracusa and Catania (Italy) and channel 9 in the provinces of Ragusa and Siracusa, as these will create harmful interferences to our allotments "AINOS" (KEFALLONIA) and "KERKYRA" respectively.

The need to include AINOS and KERKYRA in the table of usage of channels has emerged from our studies so far.

Further studies are required in order to conclude to an agreement.

We will be in contact to arrange a next meeting in order to discuss further all our coordination issues.
