

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA
(art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679)

In accordance with the EU Regulation 2016/679, the information on the processing of personal data is provided below, in compliance with the current provisions referred to the EU Regulation and the Code of personal data protection.

Personal data provided by participating on voluntary basis in the public consultation, shall be used by the Ministry of Enterprises and Made in Italy, within the forms and the limits necessary for the adoption of the measures of competence, with procedures mainly digitized and only by competent personnel units or internal bodies .

Controller of the processing, in accordance with article 4, paragraph 1, point n. 7 of the EU Regulation, is the Ministry of Enterprises and Made in Italy, headquartered in Rome (Italy), via Veneto n. 33, 00187. The functions of the Data Controller, in accordance with the Directive of the Minister of Economic Development adopted on 28th January 2020, are exercised by the Head of the Department for digital, connectivity and new technologies, in relation to competence profiles.

Data processing is implemented in compliance with lawful requirements referred to in art. 6 of the EU Regulation 2016/679 and is carried out exclusively within the rules and for the specific purposes provided by the relevant regulation, complying, in every phase of the processing, with the principles of lawfulness, correctness, integrity and privacy, enshrined in art. 5 of the EU Regulation.

The Data Controller guarantees that access to information is allowed exclusively to authorized Persons for the processing of data (art. 29 and 4, n. 10, of the EU Regulation and art. 2-quaterdecies of the Code), without prejudice to liability arising from unlawful use of the information and provides for, under its own responsibility and within the framework of its organizational structure, giving instructions to the staff in charge of the processing that, expressly designated, operate under his/her authority as authorized Persons.

In accordance with art. 5, par. 1, let. e) of the EU Regulation, acquired data are stored for the time established by the current legislation for administrative purposes and, in any case, only for the time strictly necessary for the fulfilment of the purpose for which the data are processed.

The Ministry of Enterprises and Made in Italy, as Data Controller, is committed to enable, in the easiest way possible, the exercise of the rights recognised to the interested parties in accordance with art. 15 and subsequent articles of the EU Regulation. In particular, interested parties have the right to obtain from the Ministry, in the cases provided for, access to personal data and adjustment or deletion thereof or limitation of the processing concerning them or opposing the processing.

The apposite instance can be submitted to the Data Protection Officer at the Ministry to the addresses indicated above.

Interested parties, should consider that if the processing of their personal data take place in violation of law provisions on personal data protection, they have the right to lodge a complaint to the Data Protection Authority in accordance with art. 77 of the EU Regulation or to appeal to the appropriate judicial offices in accordance with art. 79 of the EU Regulation.
